



## **Watkiss Automation Ltd. RoHS Compliance Statement**

### **RoHS Directive (2002/95/EC)**

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS) Directive was passed into law by the European Union (E.U.). It affects manufacturers, sellers, distributors and recyclers of electrical and electronic equipment containing lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chrome, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE). After July 1, 2006 the use of these materials above prescribed limits will be banned in most new products sold in Europe.

Watkiss Automation Ltd. is committed to respecting and protecting people and the environment; and to complying with applicable environmental laws and regulations.

We have therefore modified our internal practices and processes to eliminate restricted substances and materials. We have worked with all our suppliers to ensure that they understand the requirements of the RoHS Directive and that the products they supply to us are compliant.

Watkiss Automation Ltd can therefore confirm that any new product sold after July 1<sup>st</sup> 2006 will be compliant with the provisions of the RoHS Directive. Any new products sold after this date will not contain hazardous substances prohibited under the RoHS Directive, or will not contain prohibited substances exceeding the permitted levels, or will be exempted under the RoHS Directive.
